REGULATIONS GEORGIA MOUNTAIN FAIR PARADE

- Parade begins forming at 9:30 a.m. behind the Bank of Hiawassee
- **Judging will begin promptly at 9:45 a.m. Those who wish to be judged (including Marching Groups/Color Guards) must arrive prior to 9:30 a.m. If not, your float will not be judged.**
- Floats should reflect the theme of the parade.
- No organization can enter more than 2 floats.
- Parade starting time: 10:55 a.m. – rain or shine
- Prizes awarded are:

Pride of the Fair

Ribbons will be awarded to 2nd and 3rd place

Georgia Mountain Fair Award

Grand Prize of \$250.00 to the best overall entry

- **Only Parade “walkers” will be allowed to distribute candy or literature. The parade will not be slowed to allow walkers to keep pace. Please DO NOT throw items from the vehicles or encourage children to approach your entry. YOU MAY ENDANGER THEM. *Violators will be subject to removal from the parade.***
- **Moving & motorized vehicles of all types must be kept away from the horses.**
- **Position of entries in the parade will be determined by the Lions Club Parade Committee. Committee members will handle lineup.**
- **Parade marshals will maintain 20’ distance between entrants in order for Parade Announcer to identify floats and category winners.**
- ***ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ON THE PARADE ROUTE OR ON THE PARADE GROUNDS. VIOLATORS WILL BE REFERRED TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS.***

Prizes to be awarded

Grand Prize

- Trophy (to be carried during the Parade – will be kept in Fair office)
- Purple ribbon
- \$250.00 cash

Pride of the Fair

- 1st Place ribbon plus \$100.00 in cash
- 2nd Place ribbon
- 3rd Place ribbon

Ribbons should be large enough to be visible from the float as the parade progresses through town
